RE: Winter Bazaar and Carols by Candlelight

Dear Parents/ Carers,

The time is nearly upon us for our annual Winter Bazaar and Carols by Candlelight events and we are very excited to be letting you know of some of the details.

### **Christmas Jumper Day:**

We will once again be taking part in the annual 'Save the Children' Christmas Jumper Day. Children may come to school in their **Christmas jumper** on **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> December**. This will be a **non-uniform day for children**. Pupils can donate any spare coppers or change, in support of the 'Save the Children' charity which promotes children's rights, provides relief and helps support children around the world. Collection buckets will be available in the playground. Children can decorate their own top/ jumper, there is no need to buy a new jumper for the day. Football kits are not allowed. Please ensure children wear sensible shoes (no ugg boots or heels).

### **Winter Bazaar:**

The Winter Bazaar will be held on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> December from 3:30-4:45pm. There will be a cake stall (cakes from the Bake Off), things to buy (gingerbread and sweets), make and do stalls (make a paint a bauble), bouncy castle, café (milkshake, juice and cake), a visit to Santa's Grotto and face paint. There will also be a raffle; tickets will be sold from Monday 10<sup>th</sup> December in the playground. The first prize is a hamper of goodies.

Please note that due to health and safety, **no prams are allowed inside the building**. Prams must be left outside, under the canopy in the playground. We will be staggering the amount of people entering the building on the day of the bazaar, please be patient and listen to the instructions of the staff. Thank you in advance for your co-operation.

### **Great Newport Bake-Off:**

The Great Newport Bake-Off returns for its fourth year! If you would like to take part please follow these simple steps:

1. Gather your friends/family into the kitchen and bake something delicious- a cake, cupcakes, cookies etc. No bought goods please!
2. Wrap it/place it on a disposable tray/plate. Please do not bring Tupperware plates or crockery into school. Put your child's name and class on a label and attach it to your cake.
3. Bring your baked item into school on the morning of Friday 12<sup>th</sup> December. There will be tables set up in the playground. No entries accepted after the gate is locked.
4. Cakes will be judged (anonymously) during the morning of 14<sup>th</sup> December. Appearance judged only.
5. Winners will be announced at 4:15pm during the Winter Bazaar.
6. Cakes will be sold during the Bazaar.
7. **Please clearly indicate if nuts have been used.**

### **Carols by Candlelight:**

Carols by Candlelight will take place on **Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> December from 3:30-4:15pm** at Dawlish Primary School. Please use the Dawlish Road Gate to enter. The school choirs, instrumental groups and LAMDA pupils will be performing festive pieces and there will be an

opportunity to join in with a carol or two! Children who are taking part in the event will be walked up to Dawlish by members of school staff. A separate letter has been given out. If you are attending the event, please collect your child from school, as normal, and make your way up to Dawlish School to join us for an afternoon of festive fun. Please note that due to health and safety, **no prams are allowed inside the building**. Prams must be left outside, under the canopy in the playground or in the allocated area, if raining.
